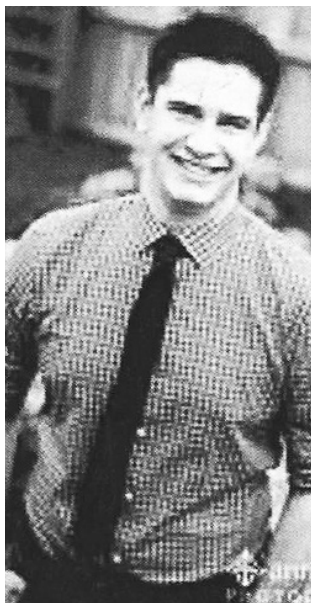


September, 2013 – Students of the Month
